Speed Dating: E-Tools for Revitalization of Contaminated Sites

This session gives participants an understanding and hands-on use of a variety of web-based and electronic tools that can be used by communities, practitioners, and other stakeholders interested in sustainable revitalization of potentially contaminated sites. Nine tools from the United States and Germany are available at nine computer stations. A live poster demonstration illustrating the application of one of the tools is available at a tenth station. The beginning of the session is dedicated to providing a quick overview of the stations and e-tools and explaining the “speed dating” process. Participants then choose the stations and e-tools that are of most interest to them and will circulate among them in 10-minute intervals for demonstrations.
